

# Hurricane Housing Recovery Program

The Hurricane Housing Recovery Program (HHRP) helps low-to-moderate-income homeowners recover from Hurricane Idalia. The HHRP has \$1.267 million allocated to rebuild or rehabilitate homes impacted by the storm or to reimburse homeowners who have already completed the repairs. Below is a list of documents required for application submission.
